If I am unavailable when you want to drop off your materials, please give them to Mrs. Baker, Ms. Christofely, or Ms. Laird in Guidance.

- 1. Completed application. Incomplete applications will not be reviewed.
- 2. One essay, 1-2 typewritten pages each (double-spaced, 12-pt. traditional font please). The essay topic is listed on the first page of the application packet.
- 3. Two letters of academic recommendation from teachers who can speak to your ability and leadership in the classroom. Your recommenders can use the attached form, or use their own letterhead.
- 4. One letter of recommendation from a coach, advisor, or supervisor who can speak of your leadership outside of the classroom. Your recommender can use the attached form, or use their own letterhead.

Please turn in all application materials together. You may paperclip your application packet, or put your packet in a large brown envelope. Please don't use report covers as they will only be thrown out.

The NHS Faculty Council will blindly review all complete application packets that have been turned in on or before the March 24<sup>th</sup> deadline. Candidates who meet the requirements of scholarship, service, leadership, and character will be granted admission to the NHS.
