3RD GRADE



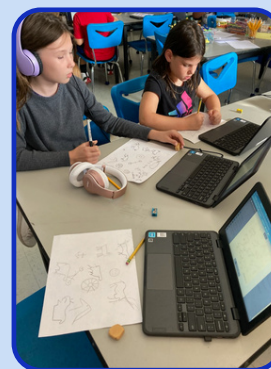
Warm and cool color geometric and organic shapes. Then, students created a focal point using glitter.
