They completed a team activity where they welded a mounting bracket for a skid steer, performed a diagnostic activity for a Caterpillar skid steer, welded an individual project, measured the output on a self-propelled John Deere field sprayer, analyzed a topographic map, completed a compact engine activity, and took a written exam. Our students were able to gain a lot of hands-on learning experience from this competition while competing against the top teams from across the country.

Outside of the competition, our students participated in a service project assembling fidget bags for children with sensory needs, attended a leadership workshop, and an agriculture and career expo.
