Challenge Day is a powerful, high-energy program in which youth and adult participants are guided through a series of experiential learning processes.

Challenge Days successfully address the issues of violence, teasing, social oppression, racism, harassment, bullying, conflict management, suicide, peer pressure, alcohol and drugs.

Challenge Day programs are designed to unite the members of the school and to empower them to carry the themes of the program back to the greater school population.

During the program, youth are given several opportunities to speak out about what's really going on for them, and what they need from one another. While our program focuses primarily on global and community issues and concerns, individual students can and often do share personal difficulties and experiences with the group. The process of sharing is often both empowering and emotional. At the conclusion of the program, the majority of youth leave feeling bonded, empowered and committed to making a positive difference.
