
FIRE & EMT ACADEMY

- Reimbursement upon successful completion










CUSTOMIZED | WORK-BASED LEARNING

- Structured Learning Experience
 - Work experience with weekly class at Polytech
- Supervised School-to-Careers
- Career Prep (GPA: 3.0)
 - Earn up to 12 college credits
 - Can include on-campus college work, online instruction, certification courses, or other types of educational experiences
 - Reimbursement upon successful completion



HOW DOES IT WORK?

- Current 10th and 11th grade students are eligible to apply; in some cases, students may be able to apply earlier
- Students complete all academics at their home high school and are bused to Polytech for half-day programs
- Most programs are two years and offer 20 practical arts credits each year. Some programs offer additional high school credit opportunities
- Each program offers a hands-on, workbased education with opportunities for students to gain college credits, licensure, credentials, skills and/or certifications


